Loris Youssef

Starting Over with Macquarie Community College: Loris's Aged Care Journey

Loris arrived in Australia in 2022 after facing difficult circumstances that forced her to leave Syria. Back home, she worked as a mechanical engineer. However, in Australia, she needed to start fresh and choose a new career path.

Loris began her aged care journey with the "Entry into Care Role Skillset" being delivered by Macquarie Community College in partnership with Settlement Services International.

Studying wasn't easy for Loris. English was not her first language, and she didn't have a computer to complete her assignments. But with the support of Macquarie Community College trainers — Leila Kaawi, Karen Hogan, and Heather Hill — Loris gained the confidence and skills she needed to move forward.

"My trainers were very helpful! I do appreciate all of them for standing by me".

The NSW Government's Adult and Community Education (ACE) Program provides affordable, local training and education to NSW communities. Under the ACE program, participants, employers, delivery partners and providers and government collaborate to improve learning outcomes for learners and meet community training needs.

Through the ACE Program funding, Loris was eligible to study the Entry into Care Role Skillset. This enabled Loris to pathway to the CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing and Disability) under the NSW Smart and Skilled funding. Loris successfully completed her Cert III gaining the essential skills and knowledge needed to provide quality care for seniors and people living with disabilities.

"I am committed to providing excellent and professional care for the elderly people," says Loris.

With this guidance, Loris has already applied for several positions and feels optimistic about securing a role soon.

At the start of 2025, Loris enrolled in the CHC43121 Certificate IV in Disability Support, continuing her journey of learning and growth and being ready to work in aged care sector.

Building a Future in Child Care: Shaista's Inspiring Journey

When Shaista Nasreen moved to Australia from Pakistan in 2019, her life took a significant turn — both personally and professionally. Transitioning to life in a new country presented unexpected challenges that would reshape her child care career path and future aspirations.

Determined to overcome her language barrier, Shaista sought an opportunity to engage more actively in her new community. After researching various educational institutes, she enrolled into CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care at Macquarie Community College.

"I was nervous about interacting with new people and managing my studies," Shaista admits. "But the support I received from my trainers made all the difference. Their encouragement helped me build confidence in my communication skills."

The journey wasn't without its hurdles. Balancing her studies with the demands of being a new mother presented its challenges. Shaista had her first child in 2020 and later welcomed her second daughter while pursuing her CHC50121 Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care. Despite these responsibilities, she persevered with the unwavering support of her husband and the guidance of trainers.

Throughout her studies at Macquarie Community College, Shaista gained a wealth of knowledge about early childhood education and its profound impact on children's lives.

She learned the importance of the Early Years Learning Framework and developmental milestones; different strategies for managing children's behaviour and creating age-appropriate learning experiences. How to provide additional support to children with special needs and the significance of observation and planning to enhance children's learning.

"Now, I understand policies and procedures, and I am aware of my role as a mandatory reporter, always prioritising children's safety," Shaista explains. "These skills have made me a more confident educator — and even more confident mother."

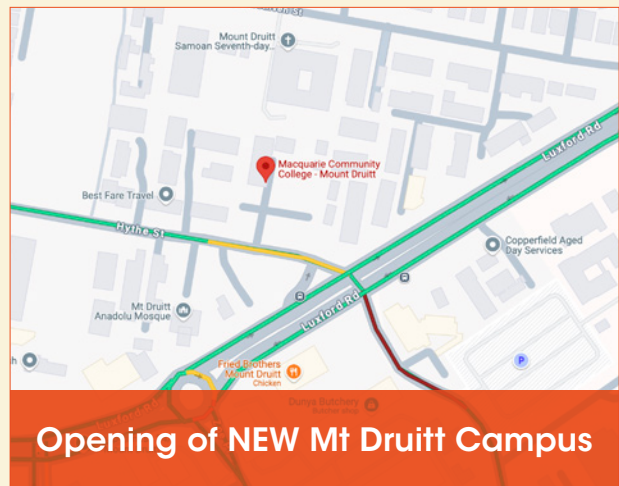

Foreign Languages



Finding your level

Foreign Languages

We have simplified the structure of our foreign language courses. This has been done based on feedback from tutors and students and with the aim of offering a more regular and consistent offering across each language and location. The previously offered 10 levels have been restricted to 4 levels – Introduction, Beginners, Intermediate and Advanced.

The introduction courses are designed as a one course only starting point for new students, but the other levels allow for students to continue until they reach the required competency to progress. The time to develop this competency will vary between students but as a guide 2 to 4 terms is often required. Continuing students should discuss with the tutor when they are ready to progress to the next level and new students with a prior background in the

language should contact the college to be assessed and placed into the correct class.

Introduction (previously Level 1)

This level is for students with little or no experience in the language. Classes will be conducted in English and students will learn greetings, basic vocabulary and some simple aspects of conversation. These courses will suit students starting out in the study of the language or just looking for some basics of the language for travel, work or social situations.

Beginners (previously Levels 2 and 3)

This level will provide the next step for students that have completed the Introduction course or have a basic knowledge of the language from previous study, travel or other exposure. Classes will be conducted in English but some basic conversations

in the chosen language will be introduced.

Intermediate (previously Levels 4 and 5)

Students should have the capacity to conduct a simple conversation using basic language. This may have been obtained through the completion of the Beginners level or other study. Classes will increasingly be delivered in the language being learnt and focus will be on more complex vocabulary, grammar, reading and writing.

Advanced (previously Level 6 and above)

Courses at this level are largely conducted in the chosen language. Students should be capable of holding a simple conversation or follow a conversation between fluent speakers. A basic understanding of reading, writing and grammar will be further developed at this level.
